Tenants' Forum

Our tenants' forum is new for 2023 and will meet will meet 4 times a year in person during the day and 4 times a year online in the evening to see what works best. The forums are a chance to meet other people, share information and hear from invited speakers. They are co-hosted by tenants and staff. There are also refreshments, interpreters where needed and a quiet room for a bit of time out. If there is demand, we will also look at providing children's activities during the meeting so families can take part.

Owners' Forum

Our Owners Forum has been meeting for over a year now, on a quarterly basis, in community halls across Govan. Govan Tenant Services Scrutiny Group (GTSSG)

Our service improvement or "scrutiny group" began in 2023. This group's role is to look at the performance and processes of Govan Housing Association in detail, to ensure we are working well or to make recommendations for improvement.

The group meets monthly in the evening, in person, with independent support from the Tenants Improvement Service, (TIS).

We work with local partners including Sunny Govan Radio, Glasgow Life and Glasgow Clyde College to signpost tenants to appropriate digital support and resources. We also have a Useful Information Sheet based on work done by our tenant group covering the four streets of Luath, Howat, Elder and Taransay, which gives information on improving mobile and wifi service and on the benefits of social tariffs.
