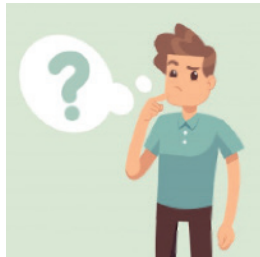


Benefits and Money Advice
